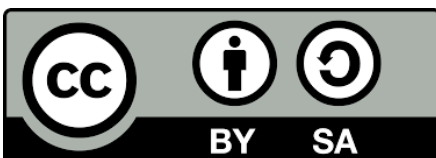


Cyberbullying
