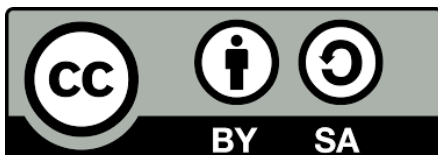


# Online Grooming
